This yearDr.Nöth focuses on the Germ an/Sw edish artist Lotte Laserstein (1898-1993), shooting star am ong the w om an artists over the past 15 years.One of the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ first fem ale students at Berlin Academ y of Fine Arts in the



1920s, raising star in the early 1930s, then tragically expelled from her country by the Nazis, she found an exile in Sw eden in 1937 and could luckily take her paintings with her. The brilliant portraitist she was, she could make a living from her art but was forgotten outside Sw eden



nonetheless. A fter two am azing exhibitions at Agnew s and Belgrave Gallery in London in 1987 at the end of her life she w as forgotten again, only to be rediscovered in 2010 w hen herm asterpiece "Evening over Potsdam" sold for half a m illion Euros at Sotheby's in London. This unexpected result for an "unknow n" artist set a turbulent developm ent of

prices in motion which has not come to an end yet. She had single artist shows in Frankfurt, Berlin, Basel, Stockholm and Malmö. Beside many private collectors, Germ an and US-American museums have started buying her paintings for their



collections.

At BRAFA Dr. Nöth w ill give an overview over her Berlin as w ellas her Sw edish w ork including sensitive portraits of the "new" em ancipated w om en of the 1920s and early 1930s, fashion drawings, sketches of tennis tournam ents, nudes, brilliant portraits of children as w ellas adults, landscapes and flow er still lives. Laserstein's portraits in her sensuous new -objectivity style as w ellas herm isty atm ospheric im pressionist landscapes deserve every attention.

The Laserstein show is com plem ented by Germ an im pression ist and expression ist painters of her tim e like Lovis Corinth, Erich

Heckel, Ludw ig Kirchner, Em ilNoble and KarlSchm idt-Rottluff.
