Martin Margiela founded Maison Martin Margiela in 1988. Right after the twentieth anniversary of his eponymous brand, Margiela decided to leave the fashion world. Since then, he has devoted himself exclusively to the visual arts. During his career, several art museums exhibited his designs, including Bozar (Brussels), Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen (Rotterdam), Haus der Kunst (Munich), LACMA (Los Angeles) and Somerset House (London).

## **BIOGRAPHY**

Martin Margiela was born in 1957 in Leuven (BE). After attending the Sint-Lukas Kunsthumaniora art school in Hasselt, he entered the fashion department of the Royal Academy of Fine Arts in Antwerp in 1977. In 1988 he founded Maison Martin Margiela. During his career, several museums exhibited his designs, such as Bozar in Brussels, Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen in Rotterdam, Haus der Kunst in Munich, LACMA in Los Angeles and Somerset House in London, among others
